The proposed solution to such problem is an implanted space into a run down buildings - a loft filling the void of decaying monuments which preserves the physical presence, memory and spirit of the place.

## The Proposo

The proposal shows XIII century Gothic church in Gnojewo (Poland) which was built in a unique brick and wood binding technique. Unfortunately there is no technical possibility and understanding of the problem within local community to preserve the church today. The sad picture of the ruined church gave birth to the idea of preserving this place by the implanted loft space.

## The Loft



Thanks to the advanced eco-friendly technologies the space becomes a truly sustainable loft of the future.













